

Barham Parish Council – December 2019 In Touch Report

Over the last few months the Parish Council have noticed that the grass land either side of the bottom of Barham Church Lane, was increasingly being used for some pretty large advertising signs, often for things that were not local to Barham and the surrounding villages. A number of these were commercial and quite distracting.

Local organisations wanting to use the area should email the Clerk in advance; appropriate signs for local events will normally be accepted with prior notice. There is now a notice on the land reminding people that 'This site is managed by the Parish Council and advertising is strictly prohibited unless prior authorisation has been given by the parish council'.

The Parish Council is very happy to receive requests for grant funding from residents or community groups. If you have a need then please the Parish Clerk who can provide the necessary forms.

The next full Parish Council Meeting is being held on Monday 2nd December at 7.30pm in Claydon and Barham Village Hall.
