BARHAM PICNIC SITE

Further to the Parish Council taking on the rejuvenation of the Barham Picnic Site. With the help of the Probation Service, DK9 security and Maurice Debenham work is already underway with making good the toilet and information block and clearing the site. Of course any local residents are most welcome to give a hand if they can spare the time. A work plan has been put together and is on the village website.

The Parish Council has Section 106 money available towards the picnic site, this money has been put a side by BMSDC in mind for the rejuvenation of the site. The Parish Council would very much like to install a MUGA (multipurpose sports area) but will need to formally apply for the money which totals £200,000. Evidence must be demonstrated that such a facility would be beneficial and used by the surrounding community.

Therefore the Parish Council would very much welcome your positive support on this proposal for a MUGA at Barham Picnic Site. A survey is currently being carried out so that we can demonstrate to BMSDC that the facility is needed and the funding will be granted. We would encourage that you take part in this survey/questionnaire which will be delivered to all households on Barham. Completed surveys are required back to the Parish Clerk by 20th February 2023. SPEEDING IN BARHAM

Sadly, local people are still using Norwich Rd, Church lane and Sandy lane as a race track we will continue to work with the Police and safe cam to enforce the law. All our speed devices record all the data which is forwarded to the Police. We will be continuing with Speed Watch and reporting all offenders, you have been warned.

On a positive note Traffic Calming the Parish Chairman is happy to report that after a 3-year battle, Highways has agreed to install larger 450mm repeater signs x 12 and new white painted roundels to the road x 8, along the Norwich Road. This will cost £3200, much less than the anticipated £20,000 originally thought. SCC Chris Chambers has kindly agreed to pay half of the cost.

"Setting the budget is one of my most important responsibilities. I must ensure that the Chief Constable has the resources she needs to provide an efficient and effective service. Later this month I will need to make a decision about the policing element of the council tax precept. I am planning to ask the Police and Crime Panel to support my proposal to raise the policing element of the precept by £15 a year (for a Band D property) which is essential to maintain an efficient and effective service, and provide the resources needed to manage demand as effectively as possible.
