### **BARHAM PICNIC SITE**

Further to the Parish Council taking on the rejuvenation of the Barham Picnic Site. With the help of the Probation Service, Otley College & The River Gipping Trust work is already underway with making good the toilet and information block and clearing the site. Of course any local residents are most welcome to give a hand if they can spare the time. A work plan has been put together and is on the village website.

The Parish Council has Section 106 money available towards the picnic site, this money has been put a side by BMSDC in mind for the rejuvenation of the site. The Parish Council would very much like to install a MUGA (multipurpose sports area) but will need to formally apply for the money which totals £200,000. Evidence must be demonstrated that such a facility would be beneficial and used by the surrounding community.

Therefore the Parish Council would very much welcome your positive support on this proposal for a MUGA at Barham Picnic Site, so that we can demonstrate to BMSDC that the facility is needed and the funding will be granted.
