Church Field site, off Church Lane, is still satisfying various pre-commencement planning conditions with Mid Suffolk District Council but monthly liaison meeting with Taylor Wimpey have been agreed once building starts in order to minimise impact on residents and an opportunity to raise your concerns.

Similarly, Ely Road building project is still to be agree by Mid Suffolk District Council.

We have received no update of the old doctor surgery site . It was sold a long time ago but as yet no planning application has been submitted.
